World War I



The home front support effort in the United States during World War I included coordination of the entire population and the economy to produce food supplies for the troops, munitions and money needed to win the war. Gardens referred to as Liberty or Victory Gardens were one of the many ideas offered to motivate people to do their part.

World War II





The Home Front support effort continued during World War II and home Victory Gardens were encouraged. In 1943, 20 million gardens were producing 8 million tons of food. Surplus was donated to support the troops.




