
Restoration Projects, Maintenance & Reorganization Continues

By the autumn of 1941, one thousand all-nylon parachutes were procured with a survey of production facilities revealing that a maximum of 16,000 nylon parachutes per month could be produced at that time. The last silk parachutes procured for the Air Force were completed during the spring of 1943, and by June 1944, approximately 228,500 man-carrying nylon parachutes were on procurement.


