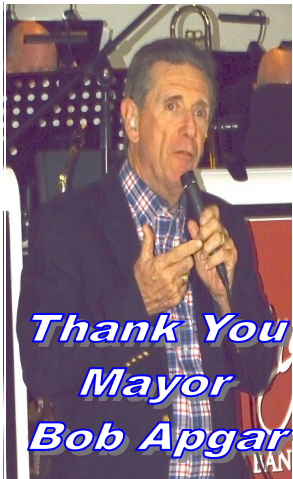

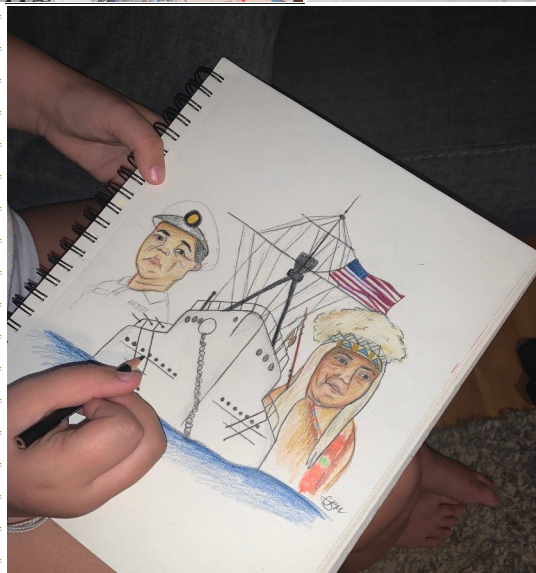

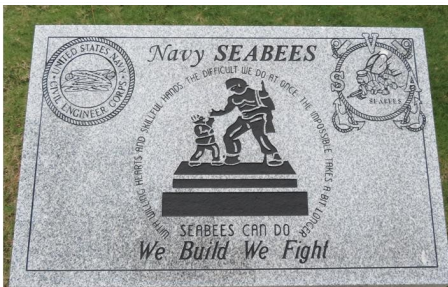

SEABEE MONUMENT & BENCH PLACED

The Navy Seabee Veterans of America, Florida Island X-19 Post of Daytona Beach, hosted a dedication ceremony at the Canaveral National Cemetery in Mims, Florida on November 13, 2019. Post members placed a Seabee monument and adjacent bench to honor and preserve the history and traditions of the Seabees past, present, and future. DNASM Vice President and Navy Seabee Veteran Don Rowley and wife Shirley attended as Don, also an Island X-19 post member, has spearheaded the monument project from the inception. In 2007, the post started their mission of placing a Seabee monument in every National Cemetery. The Seabees and Honey Bees of Island X-19 worked together to contribute \$2,000 towards materials. They also devoted numerous hours of manual labor to pour the concrete pad, transport and place the monument at the cemetery. This was the 34th monument placed under this effort. The monument features the insignia of the Civil Engineer Corps in the upper left, the Seabee Veterans of America emblem in upper right and the inscription around the centered image of the Seabee Memorial in the Arlington National Cemetery which says, *"With willing hearts and skillful hands, the difficult we do at once, the impossible takes a bit longer."* The Navy Seabee Veterans of America will continue to band together to place a monument in one hundred more National Cemeteries. Today, there are over 13,800 Seabees serving worldwide. Don and Shirley were honored with the designation of first "sitters" on the memorial bench.

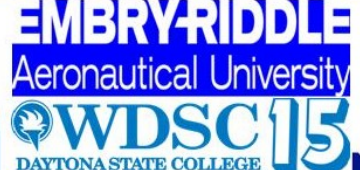

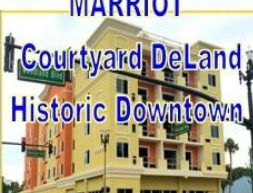

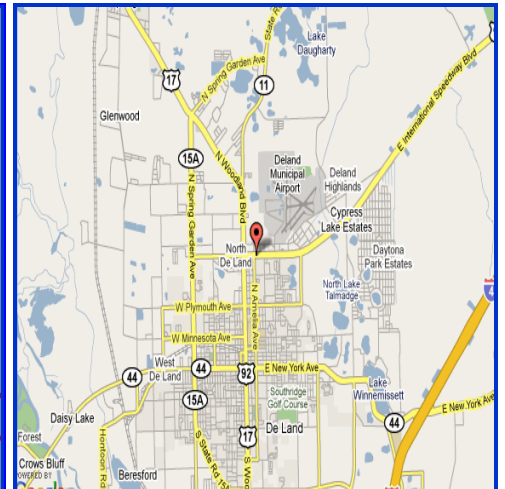
