

The Fleet Assignment at DeLand Naval Air Station during WWII was considered the best duty in the Navy. The crew of twelve operated training target boats and were on 24/7 rescue duty in the event that an aircraft went down in the water along the St. Johns River. This collection of photographs tells the story of another of the NAS DeLand activities, that of the Crescent City Boat Facility, located about 31 miles north of the station photographs

about 31 miles north of the same in Crescent City, Fla.

"Best duty in the Navy" is the term applied to an assignment at Crescent City . . . take it from any one of the 12 enlisted men on duty there or from Lt. Andrew "Jim" there or from Lt. Andrew "Jim Floyd, OINC. One's first impressions of the ac-

tivity are that things are always "ship shape" there. Lt. Floyd is alalways ways on the alert to see that every brass item has the proper shine and that the paint brush is never spared.

The enlisted men live at the Or-

ange Inn and have chow in a local restaurant. Each man has the duty every third night.

The men have recently finished

work on their recreation room, two Dallas huts that have been made into a classy "rec" room and an office. They operate their own miniature ships service.

You may have seen a number of

Dallas huts in your time but few like these. Insides of the huts have been lined with plywood, properly placed to give the right kind of decorative effects and then highly polished.


Purpose of the boat facility is to maintain and operate the boats throughout any section of the St. John's river that may be reached by the boats in event of plane

Business in that line has been at a new low in recent months though, with the coming of the planes to NAS DeLand. the fighter



The nearest thing to that type of duty at present is towing spars for glide bombing. Pride of their "fleet" is the target boat, 63 feet long. Next in size is a 33 foot rearming boat, a 24 foot personnel boat, a whale boat and another rearming barge and a






This is the pride of the Crescent City fleet—the target boat as she gets ready to get underway.


