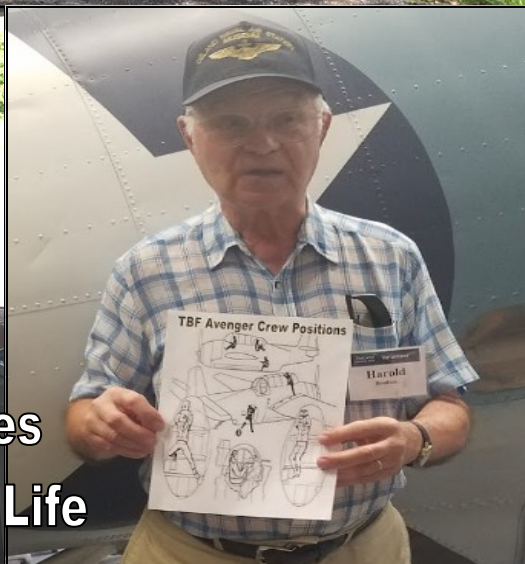

75th Wedding Anniversary Virgil & Ruth Linder

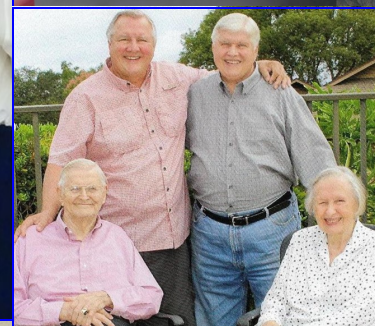


WWII Veteran

She obliged and a bond was formed that would endure longer than many people live.

He was a Barber in Downtown DeLand on West Rich Avenue and Woodland Boulevard for more than 60 years. Many remember Ruth as their DeLand High School Guidance Secretary. Members of the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum attended a celebration for the couple, hosted by their sons, Vernon and Donald Linder, at the Cloisters on Friday, June 21, 2019. 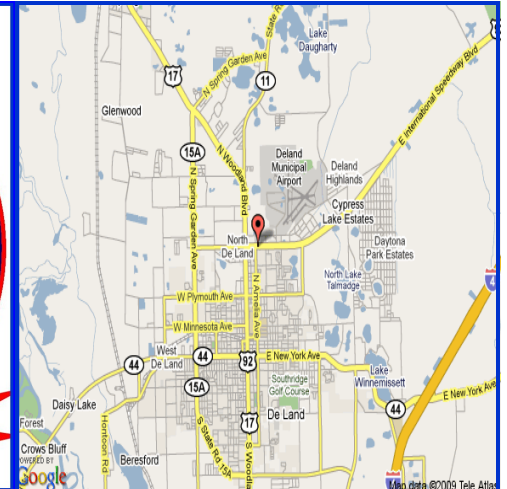
