Veterans come from all walks of life, but they all share several qualities. Courage, pride, determination, selflessness, dedication to duty and integrity. As we discovered the names of the 7 WWII crew members 77 years later, we wanted to know more about who they were, where they came from and how fate placed them together on that day.

<u>USN Pilot Lt. Frederick Lewis Speiser</u> was born on June 8, 1916 and was from Ekalka, in Carter County, Montana. He was 27 years old. He was the pilot of the aircraft. His has a memorial grave is in Arlington National Cemetery in Washington, D.C. #5134 near 3 of his flight crew.

<u>USMC Major George H. Brockway</u> was born on May 8, 1912 and was from Douglas, Converse County, Wyoming. He was 31 years old. He had one brother, John who was also a Navy Lt. His parents Earl and Elizabeth Brockway preceded him in death. His memorial grave is in Arlington National Cemetery #5130 near 3 of his flight crew.

USN Lt. Alan Harvey Schirmer was born on December 17, 1917 and was from Aberdeen, South Dakota. He was 25 years old. He left behind his widow, Betty who passed away in 2010. He was a graduate of the United States Naval Academy in the class of 1940. In the 1940 yearbook called the "The Lucky Bag" it was quoted next to his photo "O, young Lochinvar is come out of the west." Yes, Al is from South Dakota. We hear about it now and then, as Al wrapped in sweater, bathrobe, and blanket, and sitting on the radiator tells us how cold it is back there in a man's country. Al spends a lot of his afternoons over at the crew house and a lot of them just sitting while thinking deep thoughts. <u>USNR Phillip Hiram Eichelberger</u> was born on 9/26/1922 and was from Berkely Springs in Morgan County, West Virginia. He graduated with the Class of 1940 in Berkely Springs High School. He was 23 years old and his memorial grave is in the Greenway Cemetery in Berkely Spring, Morgan County West Virginia next to his parents Harry and Mable and his brother Joseph.

<u>USNR Melville Theodore Hess</u> was born in New York on October 19. He was a Navy Aviation Metalsmith from New Jersey at the time of his death. His memorial grave is in Arlington National Cemetery near 3 of his flight crew.

<u>USNR George Robert Morris</u> was born on January 14, 1918 and was 25 years old. He was from Cook County, Illinois. He was the 3<sup>rd</sup> of five siblings, two sisters and two brothers. He has a memorial grave next to his parents Herbert and Bessie in the Forest Home Cemetery in Forest Park, Illinois.

<u>USN George Joseph Eckels</u> was born in 1923 and was 19 years old. He was an only child and has a memorial grave in Woodlawn Cemetery in his hometown of Woodlawn in Baltimore County, Maryland next to his parents Arthur and Florence Eckels.


