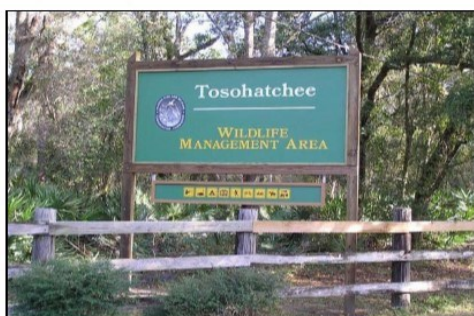

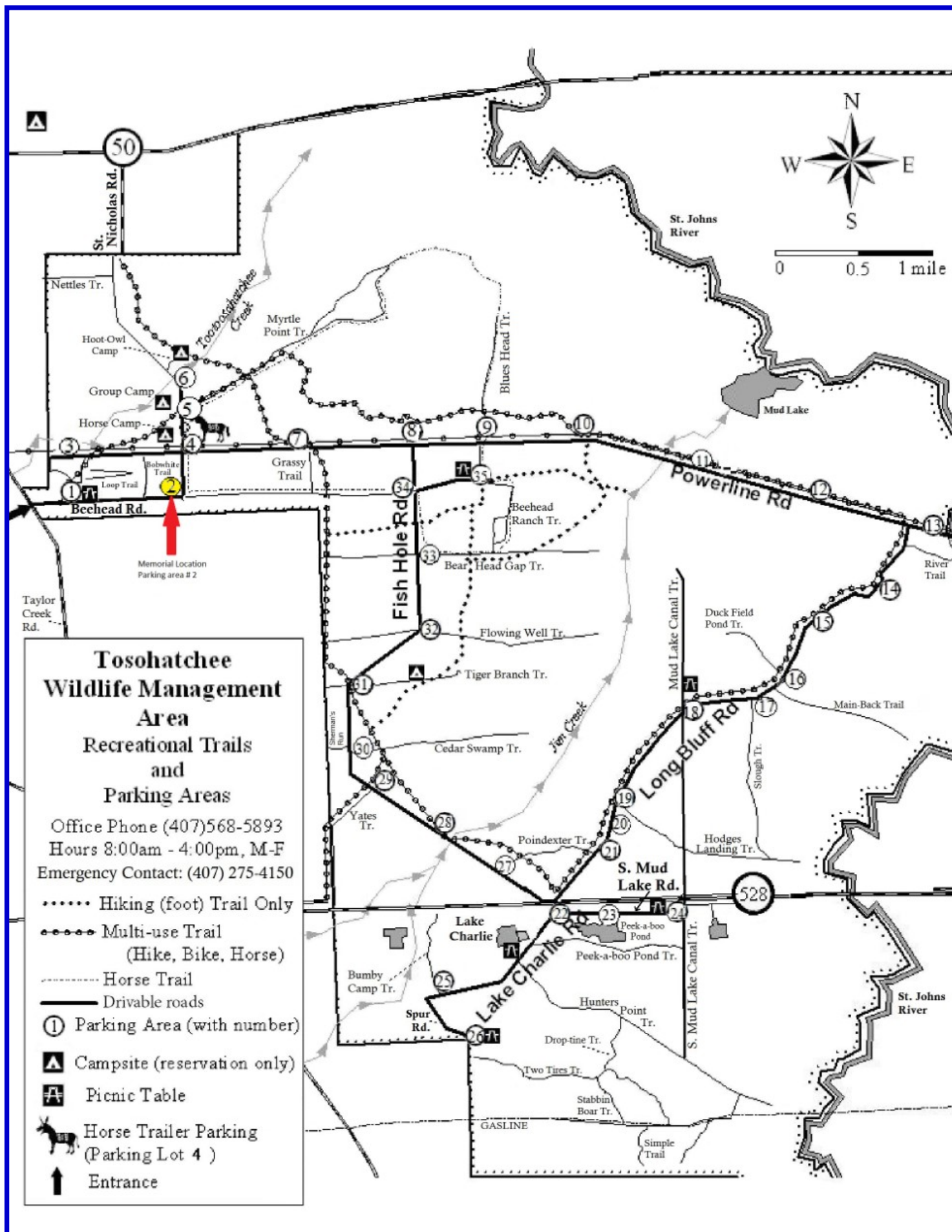

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission at the Tosohatchee Wildlife Management Area and the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum, Inc. will host a plaque dedication ceremony in memory of 7 WWII United States Navy and Marine Corp military crew members who were killed on June 19, 1943 when their plane crashed on site during a training mission from NAS Sanford, Florida. USN Pilot Lt. Frederick Speiser, USMC Major George Brockway, USN Lt. Alan H. Schrimmer, USNR Melville Hess, USNR George Morris, USNR Phillip Eichelberger and USN George Eckels will be honored and remembered on the same day, 77 years after.

DNAS Museum Remains Closed During Pandemic

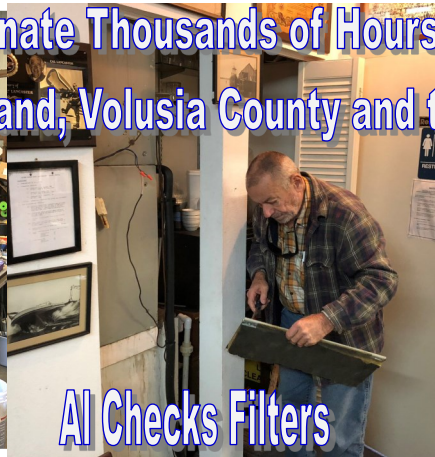
Volunteers Working Behind The Scene

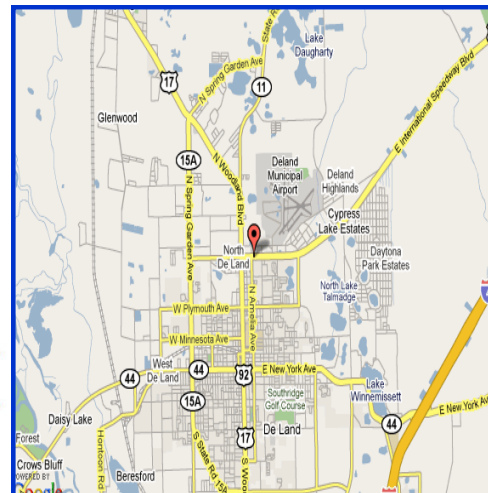

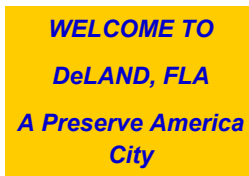
