

WWII Veteran Gene Storz at age 99 was an inspiration to us all. After his retirement and the loss of his beloved wife, Fay, he found his 2nd purpose through his volunteer commitment at the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum. Working alongside Capt. Greg Gerard and many other veterans and volunteers, the 14 year quest to restore the Grumman TBF Avenger was a great accomplishment for them all. Gene enioved educational tours for youth and adults, giving them a first hand recollection of joining the Navy at age 18 after the Pearl Harbor attack and his work on the B-24 Bombers. He worked on many other projects for the museum, including gardening, maintenance, building construction, new displays, student mentoring and community outreach. In past years, Gene was a very active volunteer for the West Volusia Historical Society, working alongside Bill and Irene Dreggors. Irene even got him to dress up as an elf for Breakfast with Santa and carefully wash china tea cups for her Mother's Day Tea. Gene had a beautiful voice and performed in the community with the Great Expectations Men's Choir along with his friends, Rabel Moremen Parson, Harold Parson and Jack Fortes. While he was separated by distance and other states from most of his family, he was surrounded at home by many photos of his family. He was very proud of them all and wished only the best for their future. It was our honor to know Gene and we will hold on to our great memories of him and his legacy.


