

Additional educational signage about the history and details of the PTF3 and the two engines on display are also being installed to assist with our visitor walking tours.




# STUDENT PATRIOTIC ART CONTEST Sponsored By Victoria Park Men's Club

### WWII DeLand, FL NAS - Recollections Joseph Gartell





Joseph B Gartrell, Jr. Navy Training

I arrived at the D.N.A.S. in early April 1944. I was assigned to a training squadron of 14 pilots, 14 gunners, and 3 flight instructors. Our training consisted of dive bombing over "Lake George". We would drop smoke bombs on a target in Lake George, Northwest of D.N.A.S. Sometimes we would dive so low that we almost would get pine tree needles in our "Dive Flaps".

We would fly out over Daytona Beach and practice shooting at targets towed by one of the SBD pilots. Sometimes our pilots would get rally close to the tow sleeves so we could make good scores. The 30 caliber bullets were color coded for each gunner.

We had ground training every day. The classes were radio, radar, communications, aircraft recognition and more gunnery practice at New Smyrna Beach, firing 30 caliber machine guns from the beach at tow targets.

One of the most memorable times was in June of 1944. There was a hurricane coming in from the Atlantic Ocean. We had to fly all of the SBD Dive Bombers to Pensacola NAS at night to get away from the storm. I flew with a marine Captain, I can't remember his name but it could have been Captain Parrish.

In April, 1944, Joseph Gartrell completed gunner training at the DeLand Florida Naval Air Station. After the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum was founded, Joe and his wife became members and frequent visitors to the DNASM as well as the West Volusia Historical Society and the Henry A. DeLand House. They would drive from Orlando to visit and share their recollections of WWII. Joe, who passed away at age 88, shared his experience in DeLand, Florida and we are honored to remember him as a treasured part of our history and heritage.
