


DNAS Museum Remains Closed During Pandemic

Volunteers Working Behind The Scene





David C. "Dave" Rigsby



Dave was deeply committed to the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum. During his time 🛖 on the DeLand City Commission from 1980 -1993 and his two terms as Mayor of DeLand from 1993 - 2001, he was a constant source of encouragement and support of the Museum.

His deeply emotional tie to the organization was inspired by his father's service during World War II.

Dave's father, also named David, served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He enlisted in 1942 as an Aviation 🏋 Radioman and was stationed at Whiting Field, near Pensacola, Florida. In 1944, the United States captured the Marshall Islands from Japan. Because of their strategic location, an airstrip was built on Enewetak Atoll that provided vital support for the U.S. forces in the Pacific. David was stationed there during the last two years of his service before being honorably discharged in 1946. Inspired by his rather's service, Dave took great pride in supporting the DeLand NAS Museum and celebrating its accomplishments.

This painting by Artist Troy White provides a vivid remembrance of World War II and the brave men and women who were honored to serve. The DeLand Naval Air Station Museum is honored to display this painting in memory of

Mayor David C. Rigsby.





DeLAND NAVAL AIR STATION MUSEUM



This ship signal light is from the USS Rankin, (AKA-103/LKA-103), a Navy *Tolland* class attack cargo ship in service with the United States Navy from 1945 to 1947 and re-commissioned between 1952 and 1971. The Rankin saw action in the late stages of World War II and was later retrofitted and used in the Mediterranean Sea during the 1950's. It was in Cuban waters during the 1962 missile crisis. The USS Rankin was decommissioned in May, 1971.

The starboard side 20" signal projector could also double as a searchlight. The two signal lights donated to the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum were salvaged in July, 1988, when the ship was sunk six miles off the coast of Florida near Stuart to create an artificial fishing and diving reef. The USS Rankin now rests on her starboard side at a depth of 130 feet and the site remains popular among fisherman and advanced scuba divers.


