

# Possible WWII Crash Site Located Tosohatchee Wildlife Management Area - Christmas, Florida






The DeLand Naval Air Station Museum was recently contacted by Staff from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission at the Tosohatchee Wildlife Management Area regarding the discovery of an old aircraft crash site, possibly from WWII. The site was discovered in a very remote area of the 30,100 acre area that was heavily damaged as a result of a wildfire last year. Debris from the crash site was revealed after recent heavy rains, when workers were conducting clearing and removal of damaged trees and brush as part of land management tasks and wildlife assessment. Attempts to identify the aircraft wildlife assessment. Attempts to identify the aircraft debris have not been successful to date. A Staff member reached out to the DeLand Naval Air Station Museum for assistance after seeing articles on-line about the Osteen WWII Crash Site discovered by Rodney Thomas. That WWII crash site identified the SBD-5 aircraft from DeLand Naval Air Station on February 1, 1944 and the pilot who was killed, Ensign William Bellmire of Delta, Colorado.

Because of the scheduled tree removal pending, Volunteers from DNAS Museum made a trip to Christmas to take photos and mark the field of debris site to assist the tree crew with avoiding the area. The photos and information collected have been forwarded to the Naval History and Heritage Command in Washington, D.C. for review. The Central Florida Metal Detecting Club was also contacted and their members will coordinate a date to visit the site and search for additional debris that might assist with the identification of the aircraft. 


